Code of Conduct

As a member of KCAMPS, members should be conscious that their actions reflect not only on themselves but on the club as well. Our behavior, both good and bad, tells the public who we are. This Code will set forth guidelines that members should keep in mind while at club events.

Members should;

- *Conduct themselves in a manner appropriate to the venue and the event
- *Promote our hobby in a positive manner
- *Share knowledge and techniques with other members
- *Participate in and promote club activities
- *Encourage fellow members to improve their skills
- *Recruit new members

Members should not;

- *Use foul language, especially in the presence of family and the general public
- *Possess drugs, alcohol or firearms
- *Engage in aggressive or violent behavior
- *Violate the rules of any venue where club activities are held
- *Make any disparaging comments regarding the club or it's members on a public forum or other venue
- *Make racist or degrading remarks towards any political, ethnic or religious group

If any Member feels that another Member has exhibited inappropriate behavior, he should report it to a member of the Executive Board. The Board will review the allegations and decide if any actions are warranted. These actions could include but are not limited to; probationary status, loss of website privileges, or being barred from club activities. Exclusion from the club would be brought forward by the Executive Board for a vote by the membership.
